

REGULATION OF AMBASSADORS

CHAPTER I – GENERAL PROVISIONS

Art. 1 – Subject matter

This Regulation governs the appointment, the mandate, the activities, the termination and the forfeiture of the Ambassadors of the Statodellarte, pursuant to Articles 56 and 90 of the Constitution. Its provisions conform to those of the Constitution and may in no case modify or alter them, and are to be read in close connection with the Charter of the Ambassadors.

Art. 2 – Nature of the mandate

The Ambassador acts in the name of the Statodellarte in the territory in which they operate, pursuant to Articles 38-43 of the Constitution, with the aim of producing and inspiring a transformation of society in a responsible direction through creative ideas and projects. The establishment of the Ambasciata is independent of the availability of reference premises, pursuant to Article 39, and is embodied in the person of the Ambassador or of the Ambassadors appointed.

CHAPTER II – APPOINTMENT AND ACCEPTANCE

Art. 3 – Conferral of the title

The Ambasciata is established through the conferral of the title of Ambassador by the Presidency of the Camera, pursuant to Article 40 of the Constitution. The Presidency assesses the candidatures received, including upon notification by the Collegio delle Ambasciate, verifying adherence to the principles of the Charter, the rootedness in the reference territory, and the capacity to reach and connect the communities of practice. In the event of disagreement among the members of the Presidency, the decision is referred to the Camera, pursuant to Article 62.

Art. 4 – Acceptance and taking office

The appointment becomes effective upon the explicit acceptance of the Charter of the Ambassadors, signed by the person concerned pursuant to Article 41 of the Constitution. The signing entails the full acceptance of the principles of the Charter and the commitment to exercise the mandate in accordance with the provisions of this Regulation and the guidelines of the Collegio delle Ambasciate. The date of signing is the date of taking office.

Art. 5 – Co-Ambassador

Within one year of taking office, the Ambassador proposes to the Presidency of the Camera the appointment of a co-Ambassador with deputy functions, pursuant to Article 41 of the Constitution. To the appointment of the co-Ambassador there applies the procedure referred to in Articles 3 and 4 of this

Regulation. In the event of the temporary absence or impediment of the holding Ambassador, the co-Ambassador exercises their functions.

CHAPTER III – ACTIVITIES AND REPORTING

Art. 6 – Activation of Forums and Mappatura

The Ambassador activates the Forums in their own territory, identifying the communities of practice to be invited in relation to the chosen theme and, as a rule, territory, carrying out the Mappatura in compliance with the requirements established by the Regulation of the Demopraxia and pursuant to Article 42 of the Constitution. The activation of a Forum may take place on the initiative of the Ambassador themselves, where they consider that the conditions for it exist, or at the impulse of the Presidency of the Camera or of the Collegio delle Ambasciate.

Art. 7 – Circoli di Partecipazione and new memberships

The Ambassador fosters the establishment of Circoli di Partecipazione for dialogue among citizens of the Statodellarte in their own territory, pursuant to Article 38 of the Constitution, and works to solicit new memberships of the Statodellarte. They cultivate relations with the communities of practice of the territory, also with a view to supporting the rooting and dissemination of the principles and messages of the Statodellarte.

Art. 8 – Initiatives and guidelines

The Ambassador carries out or promotes at least one recognised initiative per year, consistent with the Tasks of the Statodellarte referred to in Title II of the Constitution, conforming to the guidelines defined by the Collegio delle Ambasciate. Initiatives of particular significance or not provided for by the guidelines are authorised in advance by the Collegio delle Ambasciate, pursuant to Article 47 of the Constitution.

Art. 9 – Reporting and management of resources

The Ambassador keeps their profile in the public register of the Ambasciate up to date and communicates regularly, and in any case at least annually, to the Presidency of the Camera and to the Collegio delle Ambasciate the activities carried out and planned. The reporting includes the initiatives carried out, the Forums activated, the state of the Circoli di Partecipazione and every element useful to represent the work of the Ambasciata.

Resources of any nature collected in the name of the Statodellarte flow into the current accounts or analogous financial instruments indicated by Cittadellarte and are reported separately. Any in-kind contributions collected in the name of the Statodellarte are exclusively destined for the carrying out of the activities for which they were collected, in keeping with point V of the Charter. The use, even temporary, of the resources collected in the name of the Statodellarte for purposes other than those provided for is prohibited.

CHAPTER IV – TERMINATION AND FORFEITURE

Art. 10 – Termination of office

The Ambassador ceases from office through resignation, through supervening impossibility of exercising the mandate, through forfeiture pursuant to Article 11 of this Regulation, or following a ruling of the Collegio dei Garanti. Resignations are communicated in writing to the Presidency of the Camera and take immediate effect save where otherwise indicated by the person concerned. In the event of termination, every assessment of the ongoing or planned activities is referred to the Collegio delle Ambasciate, pursuant to Articles 43 and 49 of the Constitution, which may take over the running of them directly or appoint an interim regent for the strictly necessary time.

Art. 11 – Forfeiture for violation of the Charter

Pursuant to Article 41 of the Constitution, the violation of the principles and commitments of the Charter entails the automatic and immediate forfeiture of the role of Ambassador. Forfeiture operates in accordance with the following modalities, depending on the nature of the violation.

Where the violation consists of an objective fact, ascertained in an incontrovertible manner — such as, by way of example, a final criminal conviction incompatible with the role, public acts of the person concerned in manifest conflict with the Fundamentals, or formal renunciation of the citizenship of the Statodellarte — the forfeiture is declared by the Presidency of the Camera by a declaratory act, communicated to the person concerned and to the Collegio delle Ambasciate. The Presidency transmits the acts to the Collegio dei Garanti for the assessment of any further measures pursuant to Article 41 of the Constitution.

Where the violation requires a discretionary assessment of the facts or conduct, the forfeiture is pronounced by the Collegio dei Garanti by a two-thirds majority of those present, pursuant to Article 70 of the Constitution, in compliance with the adversarial procedure provided for by the Regulation of the Collegio dei Garanti. By the same majority the Collegio may propose to Cittadellarte the adoption of the further measures provided for by Article 70, including suspension and, in cases of violations of particular gravity, the exclusion of those responsible for the violations from the Statodellarte.

Against the ruling of forfeiture of the Collegio dei Garanti, the person concerned may submit to the Collegio itself, within thirty days of the communication, a reasoned request for review. The Collegio decides on the admissibility of the review by a two-thirds majority of those present; where the review is admitted, the Collegio rules again. The ruling given on review is not subject to appeal. The final measure is communicated to the person concerned, to the Collegio delle Ambasciate and recorded in the register of the Ambasciate.

There remain unaffected, in cases that justify it, the legal actions for the protection of Cittadellarte and of the Statodellarte against those responsible for violations that have caused pecuniary, reputational or image-related harm, or that have entailed the unauthorised use of the name, symbol or title of the Statodellarte. The assessment of the appropriateness of undertaking such actions is referred to Cittadellarte, including upon notification by the Presidency of the Camera or by the Collegio dei Garanti.

CHAPTER V – FINAL PROVISIONS

Art. 12 – Entry into force and amendments

This Regulation, drawn up by Cittadellarte and delivered to the Statodellarte pursuant to the transitional provisions of the Constitution, enters into force with the inaugural session of the Camera, concurrently with the entry into force of the Constitution. It may subsequently be amended by the Camera by the procedure of Article 56 of the Constitution, upon a proposal of the Presidency. The amendments may in no case modify or alter the provisions of the Constitution.
