

CODE OF ETHICS OF THE PRESIDENCY OF THE CAMERA

Preamble

The Presidency of the *Camera* of the Statodellarte represents the Statodellarte in international, public and institutional relations. Whoever accepts its appointment assumes the responsibility of embodying, in their own personal conduct and in the exercise of the functions conferred, the founding values of the Statodellarte.

This Code of Ethics, elaborated by Cittadellarte and delivered to the Statodellarte pursuant to the transitional provisions of the Constitution, enters into force with the inaugural session of the Camera. It expresses the principles that each member of the Presidency recognises as their own upon the acceptance of the appointment, pursuant to Article 52 of the Constitution. It may subsequently be amended by the Camera by the procedure referred to in Article 56 of the Constitution, on the proposal of the Presidency. The amendments may in no case modify or alter the provisions of the Constitution.

1. Vocation for Peace

Every member of the Presidency operates as a witness to Preventive Peace. They reject every logic of predation, of domination or of the instrumentalisation of persons. They work so that every action of the Presidency contributes to preventing conflict and to building the conditions of peaceful coexistence, in the awareness that every war is genocidal and every life it extinguishes is a universal crime.

2. The Trinamic Formula of Creation

The members of the Presidency recognise in the trinamic Formula of Creation the guiding principle of the Statodellarte. They commit to practising it in their own action: welcoming differences as a foundation and not as a threat, seeking in the encounter between different and opposite positions the birth of unprecedented solutions, and placing creative synthesis before the logic of prevalence.

3. Service and Absence of Personal Profit

The function of member of the Presidency is exercised in a spirit of service towards the Statodellarte and its communities. The members refrain from drawing any personal advantage, whether of wealth or of position, from the office held. They operate outside any logic of profit, in conformity with the nature of the Statodellarte.

4. Integrity and Coherence

Each member of the Presidency maintains a personal conduct coherent with the Fundamentals of the Constitution, both in the exercise of their functions and in public life. They avoid situations of conflict of interest, even merely potential, and, should they arise, they report them promptly to the other members of the Presidency and to the Collegio dei Garanti. They do not take on commitments, offices or relations that may compromise the independence of their judgement or the credibility of the Statodellarte.

5. Respect for Human Dignity

The members of the Presidency recognise that every human being is endowed with reason and conscience and is called to use their own creativity in a spirit of fraternity and mutual respect. They commit to treating every person – citizens of the Statodellarte, collaborators, external interlocutors – with equal dignity, without any discrimination. They operate in respect of gender parity and promote its extension in every sphere of activity of the Statodellarte.

6. Democratic Spirit

The Presidency is not a body of command but of coordination and proposal, in the service of the Camera and of the entire community of the Statodellarte. Its members commit to exercising their functions in a collegial and participatory spirit, fostering dialogue, listening and the search for consensus. They do not exercise the power conferred on them in an arbitrary, authoritarian or self-serving manner.

7. Transparency and Accountability

The members of the Presidency account for their conduct to the Camera and, through it, to all the citizens of the Statodellarte. They act with transparency, ensuring that the relevant information is accessible and that decisions are always reasoned. They do not conceal, manipulate or distort information.

8. Care of the Common Good

Every decision of the Presidency is oriented to the social and cultural nourishment of the communities of the Statodellarte and to the flourishing of the human. The members place the collective good before any particular interest, whether of a faction or of a single body. They work so that the resources of the Statodellarte are employed with sobriety and allocated exclusively to the purposes enshrined in the Constitution.

9. Guardianship of the Principles

The members of the Presidency consider themselves guardians of the Constitution and of its Fundamentals. They commit not to carry out or endorse acts that alter its spirit. They watch over so that the action of the Statodellarte remains faithful to its original vocation: to place the freedom of art and the trinamic Formula of Creation at the basis of a new civic-political organisation for peace and sustainability.

10. Responsibility towards Future Generations

The members of the Presidency operate in the awareness that the choices made today affect humanity and nature over the long term. They commit to assessing the effects of their decisions also in the light of their consequences for future generations, in coherence with the principle of the harmonic and dynamic balance between nature and artifice.

Acceptance

The acceptance of this Code of Ethics is a condition of effectiveness of the appointment as a member of the Presidency of the Camera of the Statodellarte, pursuant to Article 52 of the Constitution. By signing it,

the member of the Presidency declares that they know and accept the principles contained herein and that they commit to practising them in the exercise of their mandate.

Forfeiture and Review

Pursuant to Article 52 of the Constitution, the violation of the principles of this Code of Ethics entails the immediate forfeiture of the office. The forfeiture operates according to the following modalities, depending on the nature of the violation.

Where the violation consists of an objective fact, ascertained in an incontrovertible manner – such as, by way of example, a final criminal conviction incompatible with the role, public acts of the person concerned in manifest conflict with the Fundamentals, formal renunciation of citizenship of the Statodellarte, or an ascertained and serious conflict of interest not removed – the forfeiture is declared by the Presidency itself by a declaratory act, communicated to the person concerned and to the Camera. The Presidency transmits the acts to the Collegio dei Garanti for the assessment of any further measures.

Where the violation requires a discretionary assessment of the facts or conduct, the forfeiture is pronounced by the Collegio dei Garanti by a two-thirds majority of those present, in compliance with the adversarial procedure provided for by the Regulation of the Collegio dei Garanti.

Against the ruling of forfeiture by the Collegio dei Garanti, the person concerned may submit to the Collegio itself, within thirty days of the communication, a reasoned request for review. The Collegio decides on the admissibility of the review by a two-thirds majority of those present; where the review is admitted, the Collegio rules again. The ruling rendered in the review is not subject to appeal.
